**All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Competitions Committee, which reserves the right to accept, refuse, or cancel an entry without giving reason for its decision. The Committee's decision shall be final. In such cases, any entry fees paid, will also be refunded.*

**Credit card payments for entry are also accepted over the phone.*

Format of Play

Saturday – 36-hole qualifying stableford (handicap allowance will be half of the combined per pair). This is played over the White course with the leading four pairs proceeding into the “Top Flight” for Sunday. All other pairs will qualify into the following flights, from Two to Fourteen, as determined by their qualifying scores and in multiples of four pairs respectively.

Sunday – Matchplay Knockout in flights as determined by Saturday’s qualifying scores. Morning round of play will see the semi-finals for each flight, with the Afternoon seeing the finals for each flight. There will also be a third place play play off for the “Top Flight” qualifiers only on Sunday Afternoon.

Guidelines

Entry fees include: a light lunch between rounds, an evening meal after play on Saturday and a traditional Sunday lunch after the semi-finals. There is the opportunity to play a **practice round** on Friday 12th September from 2pm onwards. This will be charged at our member’s guest rate of £50.00 per person. Please book this in advance with our team in the office.

Closing date for entries is **Friday 8th August 2025**. All forms and payment must be received by the end of day. Starting details will be emailed to all successful competitors, and posted on our website. There will be **no refunds*** processed after Friday 8th August for withdrawals.

Prizes are awarded to the following – Flight One, winners, runners up, third and fourth place. Flight Two to Five, winners and runners up. Flight Six to Fourteen, winners only. Best qualifying score on Saturday.

Entries are limited to a maximum of 56 pairs with a minimum age limit of 18 and maximum individual handicap index of 18 (maximum combined handicap index, for each pair, of 30). All other entries are at the discretion of the Club’s General Manager, Mr. C. J. White. *Entries are on a first come, first served basis.*

Please ensure you arrive promptly on Saturday for your designated tee time. A reminder that failure to act in an appropriate manner may result in disqualification and when deemed appropriate, a ban from all future Hunstanton Open competitions, at the discretion of the Competitions Committee.

Terms and Conditions

Competitors should register on arrival and confirm their current handicap index.

WHS handicap index is required from a recognised golf club. For the avoidance of doubt, Hunstanton Golf Club does not recognise iGolf handicaps under any circumstances.

Competitors will be elected Honorary members of the Club for the 13th and 14th September 2025, allowing full access to clubhouse and practice facilities before and after play.

Jacket and Tie is required at the presentation of prizes on Sunday 14th September 2025.

Ties will be decided for flight positions on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole of Saturday Afternoon Qualifying. Matches finishing all square after 18 holes of matchplay on Sunday will continue until one side wins a hole. The use of **buggies** is only permitted with a medical certificate.

Slow play is unacceptable, and the Committee may impose penalties. We expect a game of foursomes to take no longer than 3 hours and 15 minutes.
